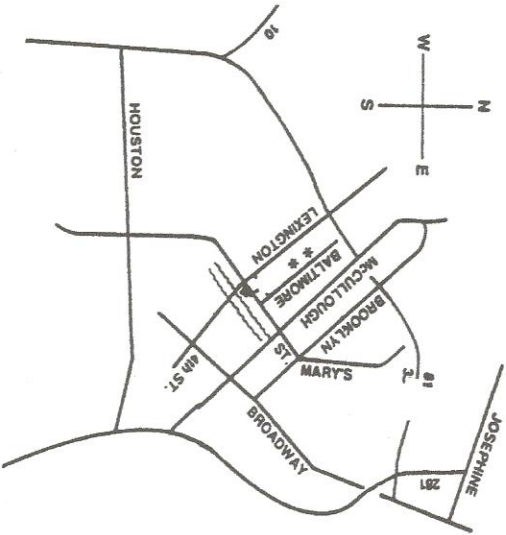

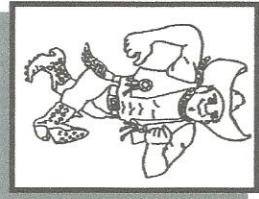
Directions:

Welcome to the Riverwalk

The *TEXAS WANDERERS* of Fort Sam Houston, AVA-006 an organization which promotes family sports is the sponsor of this walk event. This event has been sanctioned by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV).

The *Riverwalk South trail is 11Km (6.8 miles)* and the *Riverwalk North Trail is 10 Km (6.2 miles)* and both are rated level 1A. Both trails have shorter options. They are on flat terrain but are not suitable for wheel chairs because of several stairways leading to and from the River Walk. Additionally, strollers must be carried in some places. The route is not marked. Each participant will receive a map and detailed instructions. **PETS ARE NOT ADVISABLE** on the Riverwalk South.

Start and Finish at the El Tropicano Riverwalk Hotel, 110 Lexington Ave., San Antonio, TX 78205 anytime from dawn to three hours before dark. The walks must be finished before dark. There are parking lots and ten hour on street metered parking spaces nearby. Parking meters are free on Sundays and holidays.

Everyone is welcome. Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult, and everyone may walk at his/her own pace. Many people use this path and there are few places where running or jogging is appropriate. Parts of the River Walk go through businesses and sidewalk cafes and particular care should be taken at these places. Groups of 10 or more should write or call in advance.

There is no pre-registration. The start/finish will be self-service on an honor system basis. **A box will be available at the espresso bar on the right side of the hotel lobby.** Please be patient if there are hotel customers and allow the staff to take care of their customers first.

All walkers must register. The fee for

all registered walkers (which includes IVV credit) is \$3.00. Fees are nonrefundable. There is no "A" award for this event. "B" awards (previous year awards) are available for an additional \$1.00. **ALL CARDS MUST BE TURNED IN AT THE END OF THE WALK.** IVV insert cards will be available. Do not walk in severe weather.

Participants completing the course and paying the appropriate fees will receive credit (and "B" award if ordered). Limited quantities of awards are available as "B" awards. Please specify the year desired on your start card and on the log sheet. **These events** count towards IVV achievement awards. Participants are reminded to bring their IVV books. Event and distance credit may be earned each day you participate in the event without limit. The \$3.00 fee must be paid each time you walk if you want credit. You may walk either trail twice on the same card the same day for one fee. **Food and beverages are available** for purchase at restaurants along the route. Water is available at the Start/Finish as well as along the routes.

These events are eligible to earn "credit" to any IVV/AVA fee paying participant who may be participating in the following AVA Special Programs:

Riverwalk South: **Amphitheaters, Bridges—Spanning the USA, Making a Wish at a Water Fountain, National Register of Historic Places and Take a Walk in a City Park.**

Riverwalk North: **Amphitheaters, Bridges—Spanning the USA, Cities in Song and Take a Walk in a City Park.**
