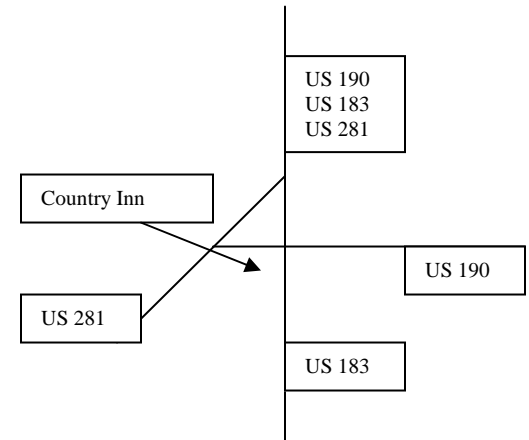

Start/Finish: Everyone must register and carry a start card

The registration desk of the Country Inn, intersection of US Highway 183 and 190, Lampasas, TX. Please allow the desk clerks to take care of their customers first, and let them know you appreciate their efforts. You may start between sunrise and three hours before dusk any day of the year. Finish before dark.

Route: The walk route is a 5/10 km trail primarily on sidewalks and paved surfaces. Short portions of the trail will be over grass and a gravel trail. **TRAIL RATING “1A”**. The trail is passable for strollers and wagons. Trail is not recommended for wheelchairs.

Directions to start: The Country Inn is located at the intersection of US highway 183 and US highway 190 on the South side of Lampasas.



SALADO

Start/Finish: Everyone must register and carry a start card

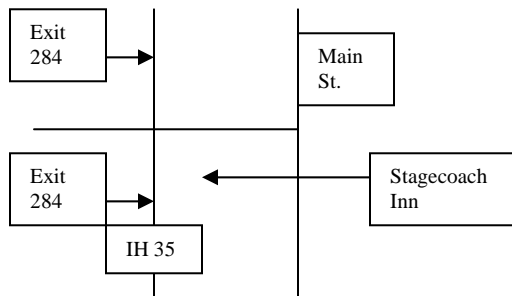
The registration desk of the Stagecoach Inn, Salado, TX. Please allow the desk clerk to take care of their customers first, and let them know you appreciate their efforts. You may start between sunrise and three hours before dusk any day of the year. Finish before dark

Route: The walk route is 5/10 km and includes historical areas, quaint shops, open areas, and residential areas. **TRAIL RATING “1A”** mostly on paved surfaces, rolling hills, and short sections on natural

surface. The trail is suitable for strollers and wagons, but is not recommended for wheelchairs.

Directions to start: From North on I-35 take Exit 284, cross over I-35 and continue to Main St., Right on Main St., cross Salado Creek, 1st Right onto Stagecoach Inn Property and continue until reaching parking area by main entrance.

From South on I-35, Exit 284, at Exxon Station turn Right and go to Main St. Follow directions above.

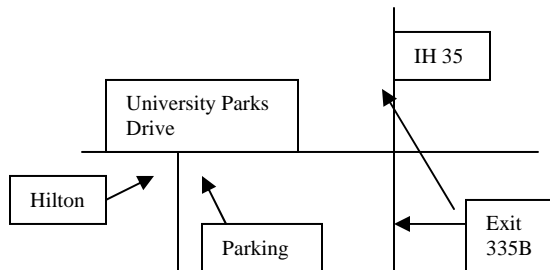
Start/Finish: Everyone must register and carry a start card

The registration desk of the Waco Hilton Inn, 113 South University Parks Drive, Waco, TX. Please allow the desk clerks to take care of their customers first, and let them know you appreciate their efforts. You may start between sunrise and three hours before dusk any day of the year. Finish before dark.

Route: REVISED ROUTE. The walk 6/11 km goes by museums, historic homes, McLennan County Court House, through Waco's Heritage Square Park, past the Dr. Pepper Museum, the Hippodrome theatre and the Brazos River Walk. **TRAIL RATING "1A"**.

Directions to start: From I-35 take Exit 335B, turn West on University Parks Drive to the Waco Hilton. This distance is approximately one-half mile.

Please use the parking lot at the Corner of Franklin Avenue and University Parks Drive (just across the street from the Hilton).



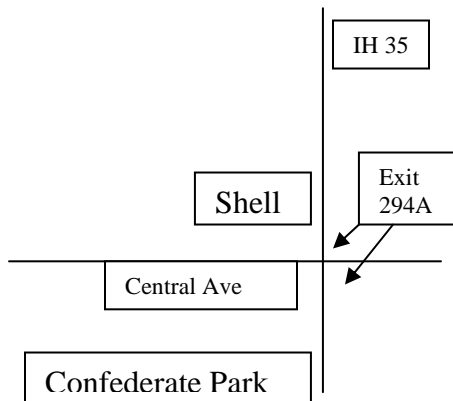
**BELTON

Start/Finish: Everyone must register and carry a start card

The cash register counter of the Shell/CEFCO Service Station #20, NW corner Southbound I-35 service road and Central Ave, Belton TX. Actual walk starts from Confederate Park, short drive. Please allow the counter clerk to take care of customers first and let them know you appreciate their efforts. You may start between sunrise and three hours before dusk any day of the year. Finish before dark.

Route: The walk route is a 5/10 km trail primarily on paved surfaces through the downtown/business district, a residential area, past the city cemetery, the campus of Mary Hardin Baylor University and a walking trail along Nolan Creek. **TRAIL RATING "1A"**. The trail is passable for strollers and wagons. Trail is not recommended for wheelchairs.

Directions to start: From North or South on I-35, Exit 294A (Central Ave). From Dallas/Fort Worth area stay on service road to Shell CEFCO on NW corner at Central Ave. From Austin area turn left on Central Ave going under I-35 to Shell CEFCO on NW corner. .
