

Directions to the Dollar General

FROM IH-35 North or South Bound:

Exit at O'Connor Road /Wurzback Parkway. Drive west on O'Connor Road to the second traffic light and the entrance to Wurzback Parkway and continue straight onto Wurzback Parkway. Exit Wurzback Parkway at Nacogdoches Road and go south 1/2 miles to the Dollar General on the right.

FROM Loop 410 East or West Bound:

Exit at Nacodoches Road and drive north on Nacogdoches Road for 2 miles to the Dollar General on the left.

Salado Creek Greenway is part of a 23 mile-long linear park system being developed by the San Antonio Parks and Recreation Department throughout San Antonio.

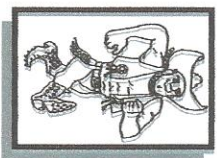

The **TEXAS WANDERERS** of Fort Sam Houston, AVA-006, an organization which promotes family sports is the sponsor of this walk event. This event has been **sanctioned** by the American Volkssport Association (AVA), a member of the International Federation of Popular Sports (IVV). Everyone is welcome; however an adult must accompany children under 12. Everyone can walk, jog, or run at their own pace. All participants must **register**, sign a waiver and carry a start card at all times.

START - Flush Juicery, 15060 San Pedro Ave., San Antonio, Texas 78323. (See map on back of the brochure). The start is available as follows; Monday through Thursday - 7 AM to 7 PM, Friday - 7 AM to 5 PM, Saturday - 10 AM to 3 PM, Sunday - 1 PM to 6 PM.

FEES - The fee for registered walkers is \$3.00 and will include IVV credit. Children under age 12 not walking for IVV credit may walk for free. All participants are required to register. There will be no preregistration and no refunds.

PETS - welcome except in the start/finish but must be on leash at all times. Please

scoop the poop.

TRAIL DESCRIPTION - The trail, rated 1A, will consist of 5 KM and 10 KM distances on city sidewalks and park trails in San Antonio. The trail is not recommended for wheelchairs but is suitable for strollers and wagons. Please stay on the designated trails and do NOT pick any of the plants or remove any objects from their place. Water is not available at the start/finish or on the trail and it is recommended that you carry water. Restrooms are available at the start/finish.

This is a credit only event. All start cards must be mailed in at the completion of the event. Event and distance credit may be earned each day you participate in the event without limit. The \$3.00 fee must be paid each time you walk if you want credit. Please bring your IVV RECORD BOOKS. This event will count towards IVV achievement awards. IVV insert cards will be available.

SPECIAL PROGRAMS - This event is eligible to earn "credit" to any IVV/AVA fee paying participant who may be participating in the **Airports—Celebrating America's Flight and Little Free Libraries** special programs.
